# MICHIGAN UMC ANNUAL CONFERENCE

Over 1,100 clergy and laity

participated in the annual conference held at Grand Traverse Resort May 30-June 1. The conference was titled "Fearless: Embracing a New Future". Hope UMC was represented by Pastor Rob Snodgrass, Bonnie Morgan and Shirley Andrews.

Central to the conference were inspiring worship services led by Bishop David Bard and Rev. Ginger Gaines-Cirelli of Foundry UMC in Washington DC supported by praise singers and musicians as well as adult and children's choirs.

Legislation dealt with financial support for active and retired clergy, efforts toward peace in the Middle East, commitment to campus ministries and the people of Haiti; maintenance of safe, compassionate, diverse environments.

Lay representatives shared local church's community outreach efforts such as adult VBS, making church kitchens available to outside groups, healing through art therapy, outreach centered around basketball games and sharing bagels and coffee with mall walkers.

Attendees with past connections to Hope UMC were Pastors Nate Starkey and Brenda Gordon, former Adamsville pastors David and Jane Knapp; sadly we learned of the deaths of former Edwardsburg pastor John Ritter as well as his wife Del.


